<b>Peanut butter or other nut or seed butters</b>	 2 Tbsp.	 3 Tbsp.	 4 Tbsp.
<b>Peanuts, soynuts, tree nuts, or seeds</b> (Can only meet up to 1/2 of the requirement.)	 1/2 oz. = 50%	 3/4 oz. = 50%	 1 oz. = 50%
<b>Yogurt</b> (Commercially prepared; plain, sweetened, or flavored.)	 1/2 cup	 3/4 cup	 1 cup
 <b>Vegetables and/or fruits</b> <small>2 or more for a total of:</small>	 1/4 cup	 1/2 cup	 3/4 cup
 <b>Grains or breads*</b>	 1/2 serving 1/2 slice	 1/2 serving 1/2 slice	 1 serving 1 slice
